Dear Morgan County Parents and Stakeholders,

In an effort to keep our schools open as well as our students and staff safe, the following mandates will be put in place beginning Monday, August 23rd through Friday, September 10th.

- Masks will be required in Buildings and on Buses.
 - If outside or 6ft apart inside, masks are not required.
 - If moving inside the building, masks are required.
- Meetings need to be held virtual if 6ft distance cannot be maintained.
- Moving classroom desks 6ft apart if possible or 3ft if not possible. If dividers are being used this is not required.

We will continue the following: checking student temperatures at the beginning of each school day, have isolation stations in the nurse area, spray/fog disinfectant after-school on Wednesday, limit visitors in the building, and keep our sanitizing stations in place as we work to keep our schools open.

If the State issues any new mandates or requirements during the school year, we will comply. If we continue to see our numbers increase in Morgan County Schools, additional precautions will be put into place to help ensure the safety of our students, staff and keep our school campuses open.

Thank you for your understanding and patience during this time as we work to keep our schools open and everyone safe.
